The City of Pasadena in partnership with the Pasadena Strawberry Festival will be holding its annual "Holiday Lighted Parade". It's time to get those creative ideas flowing, get out those decorations and lights shine up your vehicles, hitch the horses, wagons, motorcycles, and plan to be a part of the 2009 Holiday Lighted Parade. **This year's parade will be held on Saturday, December 5th at 7:00 pm at the Pasadena Fairgrounds, 7902 Fairmont Pkwy.**

All entries must be returned by December 2nd. No entry fee required.

PARADE ROUTE, the parade route will be one mile starting at 7:00 PM in the Red Bluff Parking lot on the Pasadena Fairgrounds proceed down Jimmy Harris , goes in front of the Convention Center, down the Midway, and ends in the Red Bluff Parking lot.

STAGING:

Check- In: at the Table in the Red Bluff Parking lot. **Enter from Red Bluff only**

Line up: 4:00 PM, Judging before the Parade at 6:00PM
(you can decorate in the parking lot)

Starting Time: 7:00 PM Sharp!

When arriving go to the check- in table first, sign in, pick up your number, then proceed to the line up area.

ENTRIES:

All entries (wagons, trucks, trailers, floats, motorcycles, horse drawn, etc) must be decorated and lighted. All entries are responsible for power to light their entry.

You have the option to play holiday music.

Please No 18 wheelers. We can't handle big entries.

NO Santa Clauses. The City of Pasadena will furnish the Santa Clause.

No Political advertising.

RULES OF THE ROAD

ABSOLUTELY NO THROWING OF CANDY, GUM, ETC. FROM ANY ENTRY IN THE PARADE.

To do so will cause immediate expulsion from the parade. This is a City of Pasadena ruling and for safety reasons. Only those participants walking are allowed to pass things out to the spectators along the parade route. If you have people walking with your float, truck, etc., there will be no jumping on & off any moving vehicle. Walkers will not be allowed to walk beside the moving vehicles; they must be **BEHIND OR IN FRONT OF** the vehicles. Children under the age of 5 may walk in the parade with an adult. Children who are riding on floats, trailers, trucks, etc. must be accompanied by adults at all times.

There is to be no littering either at the line up or down the parade route. If you work on your entry at the line up, please be sure to take everything with you.

No alcoholic beverages are allowed at the line up area or parade route.

Number placement will be explained at time of check in.

ENTRY FORM - Please complete the entire form. All entries must be received no later than 5:00 PM on December 2nd .

AWARDS – Awards (4 Trophies) will be presented at the Judging time 6:00 pm.

HOLD HARMLESS DECLARATION - All participants must sign a release holding the Pasadena Strawberry Festival, San Jacinto Day Foundation and the City of Pasadena harmless for any loss of property or person during the parade. Each participant or legal guardian of a minor participating must sign the release. Please feel free to copy the release form enclosed for your participants if necessary. Please assign someone to collect and turn in the releases at check in if you do not send them in with your entry form.

The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry which they deem inappropriate or not representative of this community celebration. This includes any and all organized groups which appear to be participating for the purpose of protesting for or against a cause.
